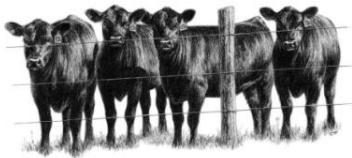

**“The Path of Least Resistance” – Dorothy Erickson, DVM**
