The Fresh Start Protocol Entails

Triple Protection

The Fresh Start Triple Protection Protocol includes:

Three Products

1. Enviracor J-5, 3 doses of vaccine given as follows;

1st dose at 7 months of gestation 2nd dose at 8 months of gestation 3rd dose within 2 weeks following calving

2. A Pfizer dry cow antibiotic treatment

3. Orbeseal at dry off

- Cows enter the protocol at 7 months of gestation when they receive first dose of Enviracor
- · Pfizer will cover the cost of milk culture for each clinical mastitis occurring before 60 days in milk
- \$100.00 towards treatment when E.coli is isolated on culture

Double Protection

The Fresh Start Double Protection Protocol includes:

Two Products

1. A Pfizer dry cow antibiotic treatment

2. Orbeseal at dry off

- Cows enter the protocol at 7 months of gestation when they receive antibiotic therapy for dry cow and internal teat sealant
- Pfizer will cover the cost of milk culture for each clinical mastitis occurring before 60 days in milk

Tips to ensure a high quality sample for culture

- 1. Thoroughly clean hands or wear clean milking gloves, clean quarter(s) to be sampled.
- 2. Wipe teat end with alcohol wipe.
- 3. Collect sample(s) to be cultured in sterile culture tubes. Label with farm and cow ID.
- 4. If sample cannot be dropped off within 12 hours freeze, otherwise keep in fridge until drop off.
- 5. Samples are cultured at Kirkton Vet Clinic and results are given in 24 hrs.
